LEADLINE DIVISION

30. LEADLINE (RIHA only, "C" rated) - Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown collectively at the walk and individually at the trot. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader must be on foot and must be over 14 years of age. May not compete in any other under saddle class at this show.

31. LEADLINE SUITABILITY (RIHA, "C" rated) - Same specifications as class 39.

32. LEADLINE CHAMPIONSHIP (unrated) - Same specifications as class 30.

WALK TROT EQUITATION DIVISION*

To be shown at a walk and trot or jog ONLY. Entries may not compete in any class requiring canter.

33. WALK TROT EQUITATION - Open to riders 10 years of age and under.

34. WALK TROT EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP – Same specifications as class 33.

37. WALK TROT EQUITATION 11 & OVER – Open to riders 11 years of age and over.

38. WALK TROT EQUITATION 11 & OVER CHAMPIONSHIP – Same specifications as class 37.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to riders twelve years of age and under. Riders may not compete in any other equitation class at any show, and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter.

27. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION FLAT*
Walk, trot & canter. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

19. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION FENCES*
To be shown at a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18' in height; No combinations.

20. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION FENCES/MHJ QUALIFIER

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to riders 13 years and over including amateur adults who have not competed at any other show or class where jumps have exceeded 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter at the option of the rider.

29. Long Stirrup Equitation Flat
23&24. Long Stirrup Equitation Fences

OPEN EQUITATION DIVISION*

90. OPEN EQUITATION 11 AND UNDER FLAT - For Juniors who have not reached their 12th birthday. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1 - 7.

92. OPEN EQUITATION 11 AND UNDER FENCES – For Juniors who have not reached their 12th birthday. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Tests 1 - 7.

91. OPEN EQUITATION 12-14 FLAT - For Juniors between the ages of 12-14. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1 - 8."

93. OPEN EQUITATION 12-14 FENCES - For Juniors between the ages of 12-14. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Tests 1 - 8.

66. OPEN EQUITATION 15-17 FLAT - For Juniors 15-17 years of age. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1 - 19.

67. OPEN EQUITATION 15-17 FENCES - For Juniors 15-17 years of age. Jumps not to exceed 3'6". Tests 1 - 19.

PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Pre-Children's Hunter and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 2'3" at a Recognized Show after December 1st of the current year. Fences 2'.

13. PRE-CHILDREN'S EQ ON THE FLAT
To be judged at a walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited. Judge may require additional tests.

3.&4. PRE-CHILDREN'S EQ. FENCES

PRE-ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to adult exhibitors who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 2'3" at a Recognized Show after December 1st of the current year. Fences 2'.

15. PRE-ADULT EQ ON THE FLAT

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited. Judge may require additional tests.

7.&8. PRE-ADULT EQUITATION FENCES

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION*

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter. Riders may not enter into any other class at the same horse show where fences exceed 3'0". Fences for horses and large ponies: 2'6"; small/medium ponies 2'0".

100. Children's Equitation - Flat

96&97. Children's Equitation Fences

MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION*

Open to Amateur Adult riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult, if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Fences are not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".

89. MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION FLAT

85. MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION FENCES

AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT EQUITATION DIVISION*

62. ADULT AMATEUR HUNT SEAT EQ FLAT - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. For riders who have reached their 18th birthday, and over. Tests 1 - 7.

60. ADULT AMATEUR HUNT SEAT EQ FENCES - For riders 18 years and over. Eight fences not to exceed 3'0".

Tests 1 - 7.

HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION

DIVISION

Open to Junior Exhibitors and Amateur Owners, however may be divided if sufficient entries.

Riders to be judged on the flat with emphasis on position, hands, seat and rider's horsemanship to execute a pleasure ride. To walk, trot and canter both ways. No martingales or tie downs. CANNOT CROSS ENTER INTO HUNT SEAT EQUITATION FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR.

47. HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION*

To be judged at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

48. HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP*

Specifications same as regular class but judge may require additional testing.

MEDALS

RIHA

95. RIHA HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL

Open to junior members of the Rhode Island Horsemen's Association who have not reached their 15th birthday and to riders 15-17 years of age who are eligible for limit equitation over fences as of December 1 in current show year and have not competed in classes in which the entry may be required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding eight fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests may be requested, at the judge's discretion. (USEF Current tests 1-8). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

71. RIHA HUNT SEAT JUNIOR MEDAL
Open to Junior members of the Rhode Island Horsemen's Association who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least three competitors must

complete the course. One win or two seconds qualifies for the finals.

83. RIHA ADULT MINI MEDAL

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Potential qualifiers will be asked to perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6" with no combinations. USEF Tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. A minimum of three exhibitors must complete the course. To qualify for the finals, an exhibitor must win one class. Once qualified a rider may continue to show in this class.

64. RIHA AM. ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL

Open to adult amateur members of the Rhode Island's Horseman's Association. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. One win or two seconds qualifies for the finals.

NEHC

72. NEHC HUNT SEAT JUNIOR MEDAL+

Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the Finals. All contestants must

wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for the qualifying classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

65. NEHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL+- Open to adult amateur members of NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Current Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified they are no longer eligible for the preliminary classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

49. NEHC HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQ MEDAL
Open to Junior Members of the New England Horsemen's Council. All contestants are to show at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To fill a class, three (3) competitors must show and be judged with proper appointments. At least the top four contestants are then required to perform one of two published tests.

MHJ

94. MHJ MINI MEDAL

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the current year (exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the current year). To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may cross-enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the finals. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2011. After Aug. 1, 2011 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

70. MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL

Open to Junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1. All contestants are required to perform over

at least 6 fences not to exceed 3' in height. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify.

82. MHJ ADULT MINI MEDAL
Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Potential qualifiers will be asked to perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6" with no combinations. USEF Tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2013. After Aug. 1, 2013 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

63. MHJ ADULT MEDAL

Open to all Amateur Adult competitors. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified riders may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2011. After Aug. 1, 2011 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class. At the Finals, class will be divided 18-30 and over 30.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION*

Open to riders twelve years of age and under. Riders not to compete in any other class that requires jumping fences any higher than 18". To be shown over 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. To be judged on performance and soundness.

26. SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER U/S
17&18. SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER O/F

REGISTERED TB HUNTER (RIHA only, "C" rated, JC TIP rated) - Open to Registered Thoroughbreds. Can be ridden by Junior, Amateur or Professional rider. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability as a hunter. Fences 2'6" with no combinations. 78 & 79. Registered TB Hunter O/F
82. Registered TB Hunter U/S

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER DIV. (unrated)

Open to riders 13 years and over including amateur adults who have not competed at any other show or class where jumps have exceeded 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be shown over 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. To be judged on performance and soundness. 28. Long Stirrup Hunter U/S
21&22. Long Stirrup Hunter O/F

SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION (RIHA only; "C" rated)

Non-rated. Fences not to exceed 2'3"; no limitation as to status of rider or limitation of horse or pony. 80. SCHOOLING HUNTER U/S
74&75. SCHOOLING HUNTER O/F

MODIFIED PONY HUNTER DIVISION (RIHA only; "C" rated) - Fences to be 2'. A pony/rider combination may not cross into any other hunter class over fences except equitation and pre-childrens hunters at the same show.

16. MODIFIED PONY HUNTER U/S
9&10. MODIFIED PONY HUNTER O/F

RIHA HUNTER DIVISION (RIHA only; "C" rated) - Open to Members and Non-Members. Horse/rider combinations are not eligible for any other RIHA or NEHC rated classes, excluding equitation. Open to horse or rider in their first and second

year of showing over fences, Fences not to exceed 2'6".

81. RIHA HUNTER UNDER SADDLE
76&77. RIHA HUNTER O/F

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION*

Open to Junior riders who are eligible for Limit equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Horses or ponies. Fence height 2' with no combinations. . At the same show, the same horse/rider or pony/rider may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Horse or Pony, Pony Hunters or any class where fences exceed 2'3".

12. Pre-Children's Hunter U/S
1&2. Pre-Children's Hunter O/F

PRE-ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

Open to adult riders as of December 1st of the current show year who have not jumped in any class where fences exceed 2'3".

14. Pre-Adult Hunter U/S
5&6. Pre-Adult Hunter O/F

CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION*

To be shown by Junior exhibitors. Junior exhibitors 15 - 17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses; spreads not to exceed fence height. If entries warrant, the division may be split at the discretion of show management. Same horse/pony rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except equitation at that show. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into the Regular Pony Hunter Division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the Judge.

MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER DIVISION*

Riders who are eligible for Modified Adult Equitation. Fences not to exceed 2'6". 88. MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER U/S

AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER DIVISION*

To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at the judge's discretion. Height of fences 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count.

61. AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER U/S
58&59. AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER O/F

11. 2' HUNTER CLASSIC OVER FENCES

(unrated) - Open to riders who have shown in any of the 2' classes (1-10). The rider need not be a member of any organization to compete, and does not need to qualify to compete. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness over no more than 8 fences. Scores to be announced.

25. 18" HUNTER CLASSIC OVER FENCES

(unrated) - Open to riders who have shown in any of the 18" classes (17-24). The rider need not be a member of any organization to compete, and does not need to qualify to compete. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness over no more than 8 fences. Scores to be announced.

103. 2'6" HUNTER CLASSIC OVER FENCES

(unrated) - Open to Junior, Amateur and Professional riders. Fences 2'6". The rider need not be a member of any organization

to compete, and does not need to qualify to compete. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness over no more than 8 fences. Scores to be announced.

PLEASURE

WALK TROT*

To be shown at a walk, trot or jog ONLY. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse to rider and performance.

35. WALK TROT 10&UNDER PLEASURE HORSE OR PONY

39. WALK TROT 11&OVER PLEASURE

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To be judged on manners, performance and quality at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

54. HUNTER TYPE PET PONY CHAMPIONSHIP
Same specifications as class #53.

OPEN COLOR BREED DIVISION*

Open Color Breed Model and Open Color Breed Pleasure. Open to such as Palominos, Buckskins, Appaloosas, Paints, Pintos, etc.

55. OPEN COLOR BREED MODEL

To wear suitable halter or bridle. Not to be moved. Judged on conformation and characteristics of its color breed.

56. OPEN COLOR BREED PLEASURE

May be shown under English or Western tack. To be judged on performance and best color example of that breed. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog or alternative gait, and canter or lope.

57. OPEN COLOR BREED PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP

Same as #56.

43. OPEN HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE*

Open to all horses of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no

limitations as to the status of the rider. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

44. OPEN HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

Same as #43.

45. RIHA PLEASURE (RIHA only; "C" rated)

English or Western. Open to members of RIHA to be shown walk, trot, canter or lope. Must be asked to halt and back.

46. NEHC PLEASURE*

Open to members of NEHC to be shown walk, trot, canter or lope. Must be asked to halt and back.

50. OPEN LADIES PLEASURE*

Riders to be 18 years of age or over. May be shown English or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope. May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK DIVISION*

51. JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK

To be shown under English Tack. To be ridden by children under 18 years of age. May be divided into under 14 Years of Age and 14-17 Years of Age. If Class is divided, the horse or pony may enter one section only. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring, on a reasonably loose rein but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality.

52. JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to horses or ponies that have been entered, shown and judged in a qualifying class. Judging specifications same as regular class.

42. OPEN HUNTER PLEASURE CLASSIC

(unrated) - Open to all horses of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of the rider. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth

is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Judges decisions are final.

2. Management reserves the right to decline any entry, and to cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.

3. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, and pickets. Courses and will be posted at the in-gate all day.

4. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

5. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees. There will be a \$25 fee for entries unpaid at the end of the show; and a service charge of \$30 for each returned check.

6. To be eligible for any championship class, entrants must have shown in the qualifying class in that division.

7. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.

8. Management reserves the right to not delay classes due to conflicts and to not allow substitutions of classes or horses.

9. No exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge as to a decision or other matters unless he first obtains permission from the show steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.

10. An open check must be presented to the show secretary before numbers will be given out.

11. Post entries will be accepted but there will be a post entry fee the day of the show.

12. All riders must wear USEF approved headgear any where on the show grounds and must have harnesses securely fastened.
