7 & 8 - PRE-ADULT HUNT SEAT OVER FENCES. Fences to be 2'. No combinations.

#### SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

26 - SHORT STIRRUP HUNT SEAT ON THE FLAT. Open to riders 12 years of age and under. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. ONLY 8 riders to canter at the same time.  
18 - SHORT STIRRUP HUNT SEAT EQUITATION OVER FENCES. Fences to be 18".  
19 - SHORT STIRRUP HUNT SEAT EQUITATION OVER FENCES/MHJ Short Stirrup Medal. Fences to be 18".

#### LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION

28 - LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION ON THE FLAT. Open to riders 13 years of age and older who have never shown over fences exceeding 18". To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
22 & 23 - LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION OVER FENCES. Fences to be 18".

#### HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION

59 - HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION. Open to Juniors and Amateur Adults. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Riders CANNOT cross enter into any other Hunt Seat Equitation for the entire show year.  
60 - HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP. Same as class 59.

#### **MEDALS**

ALL RIDERS IN RIHA AND NEHC MEDALS MUST BE CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE

RESPECTIVE ASSOCIATION. FORMS AT SECRETARY'S BOOTH.

116 - RIHA HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL. Open to RIHA members under 15 years of age and members 15-17 who are eligible for limit equitation over fences. Riders may not have competed in classes where fences exceed 3'. Fences to be 2'6". Judge may test (USEF 1-8).  
89 - RIHA HUNT SEAT JUNIOR MEDAL. Open to Junior members of the RIHA. Fences not to exceed 3'. Judge may test (USEF 1-19).  
80 - RIHA HUNT SEAT ADULT MEDAL. Open to Amateur Adult members of the RIHA. Fences not to exceed 3'. Judge may test (USEF 1-19).  
106 - RIHA ADULT HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL. Open to Amateur Adult members of the RIHA who are eligible for the Modified Adult division. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Judge may test (USEF 1-8).  
90 - NEHC JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL. Open to Junior members of the NEHC. Fences 3' - 3'3". Judge may test (USEF 1-19).  
81 - NEHC ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL. Open to Amateur Adult members of the NEHC. Fences to be 2'9" - 3'. Judge may test (USEF 1-19).  
61 - NEHC HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION MEDAL. Open to JUNIOR members of the NEHC. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. At least the top 4 contestants are required to perform one of the tests in the NEHC rule book. Test to be determined by Judge.  
19 - MHJ SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL. Open to riders who are eligible for short stirrup. Fences not to exceed 18".  
115 - MHJ HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL. Open to riders under 15 years if age and riders 15-17 who are eligible for novice equitation over fences. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Judge may test (USEF 1-8).  
88 - MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL. Open to Juniors. Fences to be 3"  
79 - MHJ ADULT MEDAL. Open to Amateur Adults. Fences to be 3'.

105 - MHJ ADULT MINI MEDAL. Open to Amateur Adults from the Modified division. Fences 2'6".

118 - MHJ CHILDREN'S HUNT SEAT MEDAL. Fences to be 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies and horses.

98 - SCHOOLING HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
92 & 93 - SCHOOLING HUNTER OVER FENCES. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

##### SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Fences to be 18".  
25 - SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. ONLY 8 riders to canter at same time.  
16 & 17 - SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER OVER FENCES.

##### LONG STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to riders 13 years of age and older. Fences to be 18".  
25 - LONG STIRRUP HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. ONLY 8 riders to canter at same time.  
16 & 17 - LONG STIRRUP HUNTER OVER FENCES.

##### CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Shown by Junior riders. Riders 15-17 must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences. Fences to be 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, and 3' for horses.  
122 - CHILDREN'S HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Horses may be asked to hand gallop one way of the ring at Judges discretion.  
119 & 120 - CHILDREN'S HUNTER OVER FENCES.

##### MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER

Open to riders who are eligible for the Modified Adult Equitation. Fences to be 2'6".  
106 - MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
101 & 102 - MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER OVER FENCES.

##### RIHA HUNTER

(RIHA only; "C" rated)  
Horse/rider combination may not cross into any other RIHA or NEHC rated classes over fences except equitation. Open to horse OR rider in their first and second year over fences. Fences to be 2'6".  
99 - RIHA HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
94 & 95 - RIHA HUNTER OVER FENCES.

##### PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Open to Junior riders who are eligible for limit equitation over fences. Same rider/horse(pony) combination may not cross into Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter, or any class where fences exceed 2'3". Fences to be 2'.  
11 - PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways the ring.  
1 & 2 - PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER OVER FENCES.

##### PRE-ADULT HUNTER

Open to adult riders as of December 1st of the current show year who have not jumped in any class where fences exceed 2'3".  
14 - PRE-ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways the ring.  
5 & 6 - PRE-ADULT HUNTER OVER FENCES.

### AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER

Open to Amateur Adults. Fences to be 3'.  
77 - AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To go walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
73 & 74 - AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER OVER FENCES. Fences to be 3'.

### REGISTERED THOROUGHBRED HUNTER (JC TIP rated)

Open to registered Thoroughbreds. Open to all riders. Fences 2'6" with no combinations.  
100 - THOROUGHBRED HUNTER UNDER SADDLE  
96 & 97 - THOROUGHBRED HUNTER OVER FENCES.

### MODIFIED PONY HUNTER

Fences to be 2'. A rider/pony combination may not cross into any other hunter class over fences except Pre-Children's Hunter or equitation at the same show.  
15 - MODIFIED PONY HUNTER UNDER SADDLE.  
9 & 10 - MODIFIED PONY HUNTER OVER FENCES.

### HUNTER DERBIES

123 - 2'6" HUNTER DERBY. Two round (classic & handy) derby. Open to Juniors and Amateur Adults. Top 4 or 25% to ride second round. Four (4) to fill.  
91 - 2'9" HUNTER DERBY. Two round (classic & handy) derby. Open to Junior, Amateur Adults, and Professionals. Top 4 or 25% to ride second round. Four (4) to fill.

### PLEASURE CLASSES

Open to hunter type horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, quality, substance, and soundness.  
54 - HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE.

55 - HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP.

#### HUNTER TYPE PET PONY

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
48 - HUNTER TYPE PET PONY.  
49 - HUNTER TYPE PET PONY CHAMPIONSHIP.

#### PET TYPE PONY

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Ponies may not cross into Hunter Type Pet Pony or any hunter class at the same show.  
45 - MODEL PET PONY.  
46 - PET PONY UNDER SADDLE.  
43 - PET PONY TRAIL.  
47 - PET PONY CHAMPIONSHIP.

#### OPEN PLEASURE PONY

Open to riders under 18 years of age. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of ring.  
52 - OPEN PLEASURE PONY, ENGLISH & WESTERN  
53 - OPEN PLEASURE PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

#### WALK TROT PLEASURE 10 AND UNDER

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To walk and trot or jog only. May not reverse at the trot or jog.  
34 - WALK TROT HORSE OR PONY PLEASURE.  
35 - WALK TROT PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP.

#### WALK TROT PLEASURE 11 AND OVER

Open to riders 11 years of age and older

#### JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK

Open to riders under 18 years of age. To show at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.  
64 - JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK.  
65 - JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK CHAMPIONSHIP.

#### ROAD HACK

To show at the walk, trot, extended trot, canter, and hand gallop both ways of the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. The number of horses to gallop is at the discretion of the judge.

#### OPEN COLOR BREED

Open to such as Palominos, Buckskins, Appaloosas, Paints, Pintos, etc. English or Western tack.

63 - LADIES PLEASURE HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP.

56 - RIHA PLEASURE HORSE OR PONY.

70 - BRIDLE PATH HACK CHAMPIONSHIP.

### CLASSICS (UNRATED)

40 - WALK TROT CLASSIC. Open to riders from the Walk Trot divisions ONLY. English or Western.  
To walk and trot or jog both ways of the ring.  
24 - NOVICE HUNTER CLASSIC. Open to riders who have shown in any of the 18" or 2' classes. The rider need not be a member of any organization to compete and does not need to qualify to compete. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness over no more than 8 fences. Scores to be announced.  
58 - HUNTER PLEASURE CLASSIC. Open to all horses of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of the rider. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.  
124 - HUNTER CLASSIC. Open to Junior, Amateur and Professional riders. Fences 2'6". The rider need not be a member of any organization to compete and does not need to qualify to compete. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness over no more than 8 fences. Scores to be announced.

JUDGE MAY ASK FOR ADDITIONAL TESTS IN CLASSICS

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Judges decisions are final.
2. Management reserves the right to decline any entry, and to cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
3. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, and pickets. Courses and will be posted at the in-gate all day.
4. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
5. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees. There will be a \$25 fee for entries unpaid at the end of the show; and a service charge of \$30 for each returned check.
6. To be eligible for any championship class, entrants must have shown in the qualifying class in that division.
7. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
8. Management reserves the right to not delay classes due to conflicts and to not allow substitutions of classes or horses.
9. No exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge as to a decision or other matters unless he first obtains permission from the show steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.
10. An open check must be presented to the show secretary before numbers will be given out.
11. Post entries will be accepted but there will be a post entry fee the day of the show.
12. All riders must wear USEF approved headgear any where on the show grounds and must have harnesses securely fastened.
