NEHC JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL. Open to Junior members of the NEHC. Fences 3' – 3'3". Judge may test (USEF 1-19).

CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Shown by Junior riders. Riders 15-17 must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences. Fences to be 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, and 3' for horses.
CHILDREN'S HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Horses may be asked to hand gallop one way of the ring at Judges discretion.
CHILDREN'S HUNTER OVER FENCES.

MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER

Open to riders who are eligible for the Modified Adult Equitation. Fences to be 2'6".
MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE. To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.

MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER OVER FENCES.

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Open to Junior riders who are eligible for limit equitation over fences. Same rider/horse(pony) combination may not cross into Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter, or any class where fences exceed 2'3". Fences to be 2'.

Open to adult riders as of December 1st of the current show year who have not jumped in any class where fences exceed 2'3".

Open to Amateur Adults. Fences to be 3'.

Open to registered Thoroughbreds. Open

Fences to be 2'. A rider/pony combination

of any organization to compete and does
not need to qualify to compete. To be

no more than 8 fences. Scores to be
announced.
HUNTER PLEASURE CLASSIC. Open to all
horses of hunter type ordinarily used for
pleasure purposes with no limitations as
to the status of the rider. To be shown at
a walk, trot & canter both ways of the
ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth
is required. To be judged on manners,
performance, quality, presence,
substance and soundness.
HUNTER CLASSIC. Open to Junior,
Amateur and Professional riders. Fences
2'6". The rider need not be a member of
any organization to compete and does not
need to qualify to compete. To be judged
on manners, performance, quality,
presence, substance and soundness over
no more than 8 fences. Scores to be
announced.

JUDGE MAY ASK FOR ADDITIONAL TESTS
IN CLASSICS

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Covid-19 Protocols will be in effect.
2. Judges decisions are final.
3. Management reserves the right to decline any entry, and to cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
4. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, and pickets. Courses and will be posted at the in-gate all day.
5. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
6. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees. There will be a \$25 fee for entries unpaid at the end of the show; and a service charge of \$30 for each returned check.
7. To be eligible for any championship class, entrants must have shown in the qualifying class in that division.
8. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
9. Management reserves the right to not delay classes due to conflicts and to not allow substitutions of classes or horses. No exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge as to a decision or other matters unless he first obtains permission from the show steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.
10. An open check must be presented to the show secretary before numbers will be given out.
 11. Post entries WILL NOT accepted . All entries need to be in by 6:00 PM the Friday before the show.
 12. All riders must wear USEF approved headgear any where on the show grounds and must have harnesses securely fastened.
