Rules and Regulations

1. All judge's decisions are final. No exhibitor or person shall approach a judge on any matter without show manager's permission. Anyone disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit all entry fees.
2. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if in its opinion the entries warrant.
3. There will be no post-entries. All entries are due by 6PM 2 days before the show. (Fridays for Sunday shows, and Monday for Wednesday shows.). There will be no penalty scratching classes the day of the show.
4. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks.
5. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be presented in all classes unless otherwise stated or money given.
6. All exhibitors are prohibited from riding anywhere on show grounds without wearing protective headgear that has passed the current ASTM/SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if said headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until said headgear is properly in place.
7. All dogs must be on a leash.
8. Membership forms and class specifications are available at the secretary's office.
9. Under Rhode Island law, an equine professional, unless he can be shown to have failed to be in the exercise of due care, is not liable for any injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 21, of Title 4 of the General laws.
10. Courses will consist of post, rail, walls, gates, brush and flowers..
11. All riders must present current RIHA and NEHC membership cards or a copy to the show secretary prior to competing in the RIHA and NEHC medal classes.
12. No exhibitor numbers will be handed out without a signed check or payment of entries.
13. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons awarded for all divisions.
14. Schooling and lunging will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating this rule will forfeit their entry fees and not be allowed to show.
15. Regular and all money classes will be \$20.00. Medal classes will be \$35.00.

Class Descriptions

92. Lead Line Equitation --RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader shall be on foot and at least 14 years of age. Riders may not compete in any other classes except Lead Line Suitability.

93. Lead Line Suitability--RIHA rated "C"

Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on suitability and manners of mount. Leader shall be on foot and at least 14 years of age. Riders may not compete in any other class except Lead line Equitation.

Walk Trot Equitation-- NEHC rated "A"/RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 10 years of age or younger. To be shown at the walk, trot/jog only. No child entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

94. Walk/Trot Equitation

95. Walk/Trot Equitation Championship

Walk Trot Pleasure--NEHC rated "AA"/RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 10 years of age or younger. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No child entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse/pony to rider and performance. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship.

96. Walk/ Trot Pleasure \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

97. Walk/Trot Pleasure Championship \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Walk Trot 11 and Over Equitation-- NEHC rated "A"/RIHA rated "A"

The Walk-Trot 11 & Over divisions are based on the Rider's ability only. In the interest of safety, it is not based on the horse's ability (i.e. Green or Novice horse). Open to junior and adult amateur riders 11 years of age and older who have not cantered in a show for the past three years. No person entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope during the current show year. Once a rider has cantered in a show they are no longer eligible for this division. To be shown at a walk, trot, jog or alternate gait both ways of the ring and will be asked to reverse at the walk. No tests will be called. Must be entered, shown and judged in qualifying class to be eligible for championship.

98. Walk/Trot 11 and Over Equitation

99. Walk/Trot Equitation 11 and Over Championship

Walk Trot 11 and Over Pleasure--NEHC rated "AA"/RIHA rated "A"

The Walk-Trot 11 & Over divisions are based on the Rider's ability only. In the interest of safety, it is not based on the horse's ability (i.e. Green or Novice horse). Open to junior and adult amateur riders 11 years of age and older who have not cantered in a show for the past three years. No person entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope during the current show year. Once a rider has cantered in a show they are no longer eligible for this division. To be shown at a walk, trot, jog or alternate gait both ways of the ring and will be asked to reverse at the walk. No tests will be called. Must be entered, shown and judged in qualifying class to be eligible for championship class.

100. Walk/ Trot 11 and Over Pleasure \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

101. Walk/Trot 11 and Over Pleasure Championship \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

108. RIHA Pleasure--RIHA Rated "AA"

Open to horses and ponies usually used for pleasure purposes that are owned by a members of the RI Horseman's Association. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Must be asked to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order.

109 NEHC Open Pleasure Horse or Pony--NEHC rated "C".

To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Must be asked to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order. All horse's/ponies shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type.

Hunter Type Pet Pony--NEHC rated "AA"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to riders under 14 years old. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability to rider. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

103. Hunter Type Pet Pony Championship \$40, \$30, \$20, \$10

Pet Pony--NEHC unrated/RIHA rated "C"

Open to riders under 14 years old. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability to rider. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

Junior Exhibitor's Hack -- --NEHC rated "AA"/RIHA rated "A"

To be shown under English Tack. To be ridden by children under 18 years of age. May be divided. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring, on a reasonably loose rein but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

104. Junior Exhibitor's Hack \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

105. Junior Exhibitor's Hack Championship \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Hunter Pleasure - NEHC rated "C" / RIHA rated "C"

Open to all horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. To be shown at the walk, trot/jog and canter/lope. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Rider may be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence and soundness. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

Bridle Path Hack--RIHA rated "C"

Open to horses to be shown under English tack. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a reasonable loose rein but without loss of contact. Shall stand quietly and back readily. Shall be judged on manners, performance, and quality. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

202. Bridle Path Hack

203. Bridle Path Hack Championship

Ladies Pleasure Horse-- NEHC rated "C"/-RIHA rated "AA"

Riders to be 18 years of age or over. May be shown English or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope. May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

204. Ladies Pleasure Horse

205. Ladies Pleasure Horse Championship

Quarter Horse Hunter - NEHC rated "C" / RIHA rated "C"

Horses must be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association. Horses to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Horses should back easily and stand quietly. Horses may change gaits at the flat-footed walk or the trot at the judge's discretion. Light contact with the horse's mouth is recommended. At the option of the judge, all or just the top eight horses may be required to hand gallop, one or both ways of the ring. Never more than eight horses to hand gallop at one time. At the hand gallop, the judge may ask the group to halt and stand quietly on a free rein (loosened rein). Must

compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

206. Quarter Horse Hunter Under Saddle

207. Quarter Horse Hunter U/S Champ

Color Breed Pleasure - NEHC rated "C" / RIHA rated "C"

Open to such as Palominos, Buckskins, Appaloosas, Paints, Pintos, etc. May be shown under English or Western tack. To be judged on performance and best color example of that breed. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog or alternative gait, and canter or lope. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

208. Color Breed Pleasure

209. Color Breed Pleasure Championship

Green Horse Pleasure – NEHC/RIHA unrated

Open to horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing. May be shown under English or Western tack at the walk and trot/jog only. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

210. Green Pleasure

211. Green Pleasure Championship

Quarter Horse Western Pleasure - NEHC rated "C" / RIHA rated "C"

Horses must be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. At the option of the judge, horses may be asked to lengthen their stride at the walk or lope, one or both ways of the ring. It is mandatory that a moderate extension of the jog be asked for in at least one direction. Cadence and balance with smoothness is more essential than speed. Riders should sit at the moderated extension of the jog. Horses are required to back easily and stand quietly. Horses are to be reversed to the inside (away from the rail). They may be required to reverse at the walk or jog at the discrimination of the judge, but shall not be asked to reverse at the lope. Judge may ask for additional work of the same nature from any horse. He is not to ask for work other than that listed above. This class will be judged on the performance and conformation of the horse at the discretion of the judge. Entries will be penalized for excessive speed or being on wrong leads. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

212. Quarter Horse Western Pleasure

213. Quarter Horse Western Pleasure Champ

Junior Western/Reining Seat Equitation – NEHC rated "C" / RIHA rated "A"

Open to Junior Members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. Riders shall be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are to enter the ring at a walk and will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back.

In classes for children under 15, the rider will not be required to dismount and mount. To be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

214. Junior Western/Reining Seat Equitation

215. Junior Western/Reining Seat Eq Champ

NEHC Junior Western/Reining Medal

Open to Junior Members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. Riders shall be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are to enter the ring at a walk and will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. To fill a class, three competitors must show with proper appointments. At least the top three contestants are required to perform the following test: 1. Starting 20 feet off the right rail, jog to center - Halt. 2. Turn 1/4 turn to left - Halt. 3. Lope circle left lead (Simple or Flying change optional). 4. Lope circle right lead. 5. Halt - turn right 1/2 turn. 6. Jog back to center, turn left and continue jogging to

end of ring. 7. Halt - back two horse lengths. Return to the lineup. (See NEHC rule book for additional information.)

216. NEHC Junior Western/Reining Medal

Amateur Adult Western/Reining Seat Equitation – NECH rated “B” / RIHA rated “A”

Open to all Amateur Adult Members of the New England Horsemen’s Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. Riders shall be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are to enter the ring at a walk and will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. To be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

217. Amateur Adult Western/Reining Eq

218. Amateur Adult Western/Reining Eq Champ

NEHC Adult Western/Reining Medal

Open to Amateur Adult Members of the New England Horsemen’s Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. Riders shall be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are to enter the ring at a walk and will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. To fill a class, three competitors must show with proper appointments. At least the top three contestants are required to perform the following test: 1. Starting 20 feet off the right rail, jog to center - Halt. 2. Turn 1/4 turn to left - Halt 3. Lope circle left lead (Simple or Flying change optional). 4. Lope circle right lead. 5. Halt - turn right 1/2 turn. 6. Jog back to center, turn left and continue jogging to end of ring. 7. Halt - back two horse lengths. Return to the lineup. (See NEHC rule book for additional information.)

219. NEHC Adult Western/Reining Medal

Hunt Seat Pleasure Equitation – NEHC rated “A” / RIHA rated “A”

All riders in this division must wear hard hats with harnesses. Cannot cross enter into Hunter Seat Equitation for the entire show year. Open to Junior Exhibitors and Amateur Adults, however may be divided if sufficient entries. Riders to be judged on the flat with emphasis on position, hands, seat and the rider’s horsemanship to execute a pleasure ride. No martingales or tie downs.. Must compete in regular class to be eligible for Championship class.

220. Hunt Seat Pleasure Equitation

221. Hunt Seat Pleasure Equitation Champ

RIHA Hunt Seat Pleasure Medal

Open to Juniors and Adults. May be split if three of each section (Junior and Adult. For classes with less than three competitors 1/2 points will be given and NO medal will be awarded. Riders may continue to compete in medal even after qualified. All exhibitors must be RIHA members and not have shown in any Hunt Seat Equitation over fences for the entire year. All contestants are to show at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. At least the top four contestants (if available) are then required to perform one of the Test A or Test B in the RIHA Rule Book.

222. RIHA Hunt Seat Pleasure Medal

NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Pleasure Medal

Open to Junior Members of the New England Horsemen’s Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are to show at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To fill a class, three (3) competitors must show and be judge d with proper appointments. At least the top four contestants are then required to perform Test A or Test B, as described in the NEHC Rule Book.

223. NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Pleasure Medal

NEHC Adult Hunt Seat Pleasure Medal

Open to Amateur Adult Members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are to show at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To fill a class, three (3) competitors must show and be judged with proper appointments. At least the top four contestants are then required to perform Test A or Test B, as described in the NEHC Rule Book.

224. NEHC Adult Hunt Seat Pleasure Medal

Equitation

Modified Amateur Adult Equitation--NEHC rated "A" / RIHA rated "A"

Open to adult amateurs who, as of Dec. 1st of the current show year, have not won 6 blue ribbons at a recognized show in Adult eq. classes. Including Adult medal classes but excluding Modified adult classes. For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult, if as of Dec. 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past 2 years. Fences not to exceed 2' 6". Riders in this division may not ride in any other classes where fences exceed 2' 6".

55. Modified Amateur Adult Equitation over fences / MHJ Adult Mini Medal

Children's Equitation--NEHC rated "A" / RIHA rated "A"

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 3' at a recognized show after Dec. 1st of the current year. Fences not to exceed 2' 6".

29 & 30. Children's Equitation over fences

31. Children's Equitation over fences / MHJ Children's Medal

32. Children's Equitation on the flat

Pre-Children's / Pre-Adult Equitation – RIHA rated "A"

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Pre-Children's Hunter or Pre-Adult Hunter and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 2'3" at a Recognized Show after December 1st of the current year.

63, 64, & 65.. Pre-Children's / Pre-Adult Equitation Over Fences

69. Pre-Children's / Pre-Adult Equitation under saddle

Short Stirrup Equitation--NEHC rated "A" / RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 12 years of age or younger. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height. To be shown over a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height. Fences may be taken at either a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. May be asked to halt and back. No more than eight riders to canter at one time.

84 & 86. Short stirrup Equitation over Fences

85. Short Stirrup Equitation over fences / MHJ SS Medal

90. Short Stirrup Equitation on the flat.

Amateur Adult MHJ Adult Medal

Open to amateur riders, eighteen years or older. Fences not to exceed 3'. To be judged in both directions at the walk, trot and canter on the flat. Martingales prohibited in flat classes.

14. MHJ Adult Medal

Junior Equitation --RIHA rated "A"

Open to all junior riders. Riders cannot cross enter into the Children's Equitation division at the same show. Fence height 3'0".

Open Hunt Seat Equitation 15-17--NEHC rated "A" / RIHA rated "A"

Open to Junior Riders 15 to 17 years of age. Fences not to exceed 3'6".

- 47. MHJ Mini Medal Medal (not NEHC/RIHA rated)

17. NEHC Amateur Adult Medal

Open to adult members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF 1--19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course.

25. NEHC Junior Medal

Open to junior members of the New England Horseman's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF1--19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the finals. Contestants that are qualified are no longer eligible for the preliminary class. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

56. & 57. RIHA Adult Mini Medal

Open to adult amateur riders of the RI Horseman's Association who, as of December 1st of the current show year, has not won 6 blue ribbons at a recognized show in Adult equitation classes. Including Adult medal classes but excluding Modified adult classes. For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they eligible for Modified Adult, if as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fenced 3' or higher within the past 2 years. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot ride in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6" Competitors will be asked to compete over a course of at least 6 fences 2'6" in height with no combinations. USEF tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. A minimum of 3 riders must complete the course. To qualify for the finals an exhibitor must win on e class. Once qualified a rider may continue to show in this class.

48. & 49. RIHA Mini Medal

Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday and riders 15-17 years of age who are not eligible for limit equitation over fences as do December 1st of the current show year and has not competed in classes which the entry may be required to jump higher than 3'. All riders to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences at a height not to exceed 2'6" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual test may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1-8) To fill the class at least 4 or more competitors must complete the course. Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into any medal classes with fences 3' or higher or compete in a division or class with fences over 3' at any show during the year. Violation of this requirement disqualifies the competitor from the finals. RIHA Mini Medal Finals top 6 contestants are to be tested (USEF 1-8).

23. & 24. RIHA Junior Medal

Open to Junior members of the RI Horseman's Association who have not reached their 18th birth- day.. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3' with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF test 1-19). To fill a class at least 3 competitors must

complete the course. For the finals, the judge shall require to work-off the top 4 competitors. One first or two seconds to qualify for the finals.

15. & 16. RIHA Adult Medal

Open to amateur Adult members of the RI Horseman's Association. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3' with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF test 1-19). To fill a class at least 3 competitors must complete the course. For the finals, the judge shall require to work-off the top 4 competitors. One first or two seconds to qualify for the finals.

Hunters

Short Stirrup Hunter-- NEHC rated "AA"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to riders 12 years of age or younger. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any other show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height. Fences may be taken at either a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be judged at the walk trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. No more than eight riders to canter at one time.

87, 88, & 89. Short Stirrup Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

91. Short Stirrup Hunter under saddle

Children's Hunter -- NEHC/RIHA rated "B"

To be shown by junior exhibitors. Juniors age 15--17 must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 2' for smalls/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, and 3' for horses.

Spreads may not exceed fence height. If extras warrant, the division to be split at the discretion of horse show management.

Same horse/pony/rider combination may not show in any their rated division except equitation at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into regular Pony Hunter Division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge.

Pre-Children's Hunter – NEHC rated "B" / RIHA rated "AA"

Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Horses or ponies. Fence height 2' with no combinations. At the same show, the same horse/rider or pony/rider may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Horse or Pony, Pony Hunters or any class where fences exceed 2'3".

Amateur Adult Hunter – NEHC rated "C" /RIHA rated "B"

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Horse/rider combinations are not eligible for the Amateur Owner Hunter Division at the same show. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at Judges discretion.

Registered Thoroughbred Hunter-- RIHA rated "AA"

Open to Registered Thoroughbreds. Can be ridden by Junior, Amateur or Professional rider. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability as a hunter. Fences 2'6" with no combinations.

59, 60, & 61 Registered TB Hunter over fences. \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

62. Registered TB Hunter under saddle

Modified Pony Hunter-- RIHA rated "B"

Shall be judged on manners, suitability to rider, and performance. A pony/rider combination may not cross into any other hunter class over fences except Pre-Children's Hunters or equitation at the same show. Fences to be 2'.

71, 72, & 73. Modified Pony Hunter over fences. \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

75. Modified Pony Hunter under saddle

Pony Hunter NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "B"

A Show Manager may divide on the day of the Show if there are sufficient entries into Small/Medium Pony Hunter and Large Pony Hunter division. Fences 2'3" for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands and 2'6" for ponies over 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 hands. Fences 3'0" for ponies over 13.2 and not exceeding 14.2 hands. . To be eligible for a Model Pony Hunter class, the pony must enter and show in one over fence class in the Pony Hunter division. Judging specifications same as for Junior Hunter division except in conformation classes where conformation may exceed 25%. In all classes manners and suitability of a pony for the rider shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized.

Open to all horses or ponies. No age limitations and no rider restrictions. No restriction of horse/pony/rider into other divisions if otherwise eligible. To be judged on performance, soundness, suitability and manners. Simple lead changes and/or trotting in corners are permitted. To be shown over a hunter type course. Combinations are optional. The same horse/rider combination may not compete in more than one fence height section at the same show. RIHA points will accrue at all heights for one combined year end award. No prize money given.
